



The great debate over allowing pets in condominiums in the state of Florida is finally coming to a head. Pet owners are uniting to help the many animals, who are tragically being euthanized, and their owners, who are being forced to give them up. Why? Because of the unfair "no pet rules," prevalent in most Florida condos at this time.

Florida State Representative Elaine Schwartz has agreed to sponsor the [Simple Majority Bill](#), which would require only 51% of unit owners to vote to allow pets. The bill includes provisions to help reduce potential animal nuisance issues: reasonable pet guidelines, committees of responsible pet owners to administer pet rules.
