

REASONABLE pet guidelines

- pets leashed or in carriers in common areas
- all pets over 6 months of age spayed or neutered
- clean up after animals and dispose of waste properly
- no hoarding
- dogs obedience trained

It is NOT reasonable to:



- Make people carry their animals
- Not let people walk their dogs around the community
- Not let people bring their animals to neighbors who want to see them
- To restrict certified service animals that are trained to do specific tasks from going anywhere (per federal disability law)



It IS reasonable to say:

- No pets in the pool or clubhouse
- No pets running loose
- No jumping or biting
- No extendable leashes
- No excessive barking
- No "accidents" left not cleaned up
